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What we've been doing

- Moving away from informational-style sessions
 - More targeted professional development mapped onto core competencies
 - (Navigate software training, philosophy statement workshop, CARE reporting)
- Relationship building and identification of our needs
 - Advising subcommunities, connection with national trends, student advising survey
- Strengthening student success efforts retention is up!
 - 2 week alerts in 191 courses, outreach around early alert grades, missed enrollment deadlines, NSO standardization
- Raising the profile of advising as a profession
