


First-Year Trips Summer 2018



First-Year Trips Overview

Optional, pre-college trips and programs for incoming firstyear students to assist in their transition to WVU.

Program options vary in length, intensity, activities, depth of adventure, and level of challenge.

- Small groups of students with upperclassman leaders
- Team-building activities and initiatives
- Adventure activities: hiking, rock climbing, backpacking, whitewater rafting, service, Via Ferrata, etc.
- Daily discussions: Making the Transition, Resources for Success, Diversity and Inclusion, Healthy Decisions
- Community: students live, travel, cook, play, & learn together
- No cell phones (it's a big deal!) providing a letter in 2018
- Programs are \$95 or free for Pell Grant eligible Students!

Trips are designed to...



- Meet other incoming first-years and develop a foundation of supportive relationships
- Set goals and reflect on values for college
- Experience independence and personal responsibility in a facilitated environment
- Develop self-awareness through challenge and reflection
- 5. Foster positive relationships with WVU
- Contribute towards teamwork, leadership, & service
- Experience fun outdoor recreational opportunities

Summer 2018 Simplified

1. Trips run Saturday-Thursday every week of the summer

- Mountaineer Quest Monday-Friday
- Early Move-in Trips special schedule to end on FMI
- 2. Each week has the same array of trip 6-7 trip model offerings
 - students choose the trip model they want and the week that works with their schedule!
- 3. Many partnership offerings in 2018
- 4. ALL Trip Models are for-credit: All students who participate on a FYT will receive one additional credit towards their required First-Year Seminar

Staffing


- First-Year Trips are run by an Associate Director, two Program Coordinators, and Graduate Assistant, with the support of other professional staff in the AWV program
- Most students/parents who call in will talk to our office manager Kelly Keifer
- Trips are led by student leaders
 - Selective application process
 - 600+ hours of training (well above national average of 300 hours, includes a 3-credit Spring Semester course, Weekend trainings, & week-long training trip)
 - Wilderness First Aid certification included
 - Supported by 24/7 on-call personnel during trips

Impact



- Increased First-Year Retention
- Increased GPA, graduation rates, and sense of belonging
- 9% change in retention rate from those who participated to those who didn't (in-state students) (2012-2013)
- 10% change in retention rate from those who participated to those who didn't (out-of-state students) (2012-2013)
- 99% of participants would recommend this trip to another incoming student
- 99.6% of participant parents would recommend this trip to other parents of incoming students
