- **July 6:** Fall Bills Post Online; Students Also Will Be Emailed PDF Bills in July
- **July 26:** Fall Bills Due (Less Displayed Financial Aid)
- **July 26:** Student Health Insurance Waiver Deadline
- **August 2:** Last Day to Reserve Books Using Financial Aid

Important Dates - Summer 2017

- Payment is due on the first day of classes of the term(s): *May 15, June 5, June 26 & July 17*
- Drop for non-payment on Wednesday, end of business: *May 17, June 7, June 28 & July 19*
- Reinstatement deadline is Friday, end of business: *May 19, June 9, June 30 & July 21*
- No May or June late fees on SUMMER balances

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS



- Measured at the end of the spring semester
- Undergraduate students must have an overall GPA of at least 2.0
- Undergraduate students must have a completion rate of at least 67% (earned hours divided by attempted hours)
- Maximum attempted hours cannot be more than 150% of those needed for degree completion (degree requires 120 hours... $120 \times 1.5 =$ maximum attempted hours of 180) ← Measured at the end of every semester
