- ✓ Exclusive access to SecureWVU events
 - ✓ Must attend one SecureWVU event per semester to remain active in program
- ✓ Opportunity to serve on Student Advisory Committee

FACULTY AND STAFF PARTNERSHIP

- ✓ **University instructors, professors, advisors and any other faculty**
