## BACKGROUND

#### What is a "time ticket"

Beginning in October 2018 for the Spring 2019 and Summer 2019 terms, students will register as always on their registration day based upon priority status or student classification, but rather than mass registration opening at 8 a.m., students will be assigned a specific time during their day where their randomly assigned time serves as the start time for registering. Registration each day begins at 8:30 a.m. and can continue through the close of business.

#### Why is there a need to make a change?

- Previous Banner concerns/slowness/lockouts
- Ellucian recommended
- Peer Institution recommended
- Worst case scenario



## **PROCESS**

 Priority Group lists provided to OUR enabled our office to appropriately assign the correct day of registration.

Undergraduate students were assigned their registration day based upon earned hours + hours in Progress for Fall 2018.

Classification	Hours
Freshman	1-29 Earned Credit Hours, Inclusive
Sophomore	30-59 Earned Credit Hours, Inclusive
Junior	60-89 Earned Credit Hours, Inclusive
Senior	90 or More Earned Hours

# SAMPLE FAQ'S

- How is my time determined?
- Where do I find my time?
  - What If I can't register at that time?
    - There's only one seat in a class and I need to graduate. Can I change my time?
    - I am "this" not a "that", so I should have a different day or time
    - I am expecting something to arrive that will change me from "this" to "that"
  - I don't have a time listed. Can I have one assigned?
  - Will I always have the same time?
  - What do I do have I have a "Hold" preventing me from registering?
