CENTER DEVELOPED TO MEET NEEDS

- Giving a home and name for connection
- Growing need to address "mild" concerns so we can focus on prevention efforts
- Allows us to offer support to a *larger range* of student concerns and questions
- Allows us to provide *more ongoing support* than previously offered to students
- Better use of CARE Team resources



SAME GOALS

- Work with students that are having complex concerns
- Assist with coordination between departments
- Navigating WVU policies and procedures
- Help connect to on- and off- campus resources
- Help students get the needed supports and resources to be *successful* at WVU



KEY FUNCTIONAL AREAS

- Resource referrals
- Letters to instructors
- Student Helpline
- Consultation and support for WVU community
- CARE Team case management

- CARE Team risk assessments
- On campus event response and support
- Hospitalization support
- Mental hygiene petition assistance
- Campus policy and procedures



BEHAVIORS ENCOURAGED TO REPORT

- Academic Concerns: absenteeism or change in academic performance, classroom disruption, disturbed writing
- Basic needs assistance (food, housing, and/or financial security)
- Concern regarding alcohol and/or other drug use
- Disastrous or traumatic event
- Extreme and inappropriate emotional outbursts (unprovoked anger/aggression, hostility)
- Health & wellbeing concern
- Hospitalization (admission)

- Inappropriate interest in weapons
- Self-harm (noticeable cuts, burns, or mutilation)
- Student death
- Suicide attempt, thoughts, or threats
- Victim of a crime
- Violence or threats of violence (veiled or direct; verbal or written)
- Withdrawing and/or decreased interest in activities
- Worrisome changes in hygiene, appearance, or behavior



C&CL LETTERS

Event Letters

- Students impacted by a major event
 - Natural disasters: WV floods, California wildfires
 - Close contacts of a student who dies on campus

Notification Criteria

- Death of a nuclear family member, grandparent or guardian/kinship caregiver
 - Not extended family, nonrelatives, or pets
 - Not loss of a relationship
- Admission into a hospital
 - Not convalescence time
 - Not ED only



C&CL LETTERS

Personal Traumatic Incident (PTI)

- Bridge the gap from the event to connection to care/support services
 - Longer term academic assistance needs documentation and accommodation through OAS
- Life-threatening experience
- Physical or sexual abuse/victim of criminal violence
- Natural disaster
- Witnessing a violent event or death
