

### **MAIN CHANGES/THINGS TO NOTE:**

- NSO Modules mandatory for all FTF to complete; all FTF pay \$175 NSO Fee
- Transfer NSO Portal will be encouraged, but not mandatory for all FTT to complete; no NSO Fee for FTT at this time
- Module information is being updated currently for Summer
- Academic Advising will continue to be virtual
- NO MORE DESTINATION. Orientation (in-person) will run throughout the month of June, a few dates in July and one date in August.
- Returning to having an academic session for students at NSO. Strengths 101 instead of Advising!
- Basecamp (non-mandatory) will occur the night before each NSO, except for the July/August dates.
- August NSO Date still complete modules and advising will continue virtually shortened day,
   move-in afterwards
